



John Edward Stitt

November 20, 1928 - January 11, 2015

He made his entrance into this world a perfectly beautiful soul on November 20, 1928 in Lombard, Ill. He exited this realm with a shining spirit full of love, wholly intact on January 11, 2015.

In the interim he received a BA degree in Business at Albion College in Michigan. He attended Law School at SMU, and enlisted in the US Navy in May, 1951. Jack served aboard the USS Helena in Korean combat and was awarded numerous medals. Afterwards he formed his own commercial real estate firm in Dallas, Texas. He was actively involved in the United Way and Dallas Cares, an organization formed to help POW families during the Vietnam War. He retired in 1991.

Jack relocated to Corsicana, Texas and enjoyed the outdoors and his involvement in the Warehouse Theatre. He appeared in several plays including "Annie", "Busy Body", and "Over the River and Through the Woods".

He later joined Wal-Mart and was known as Jack, the People Greeter.

He is survived by his loving wife Sally Turner Stitt, and two loving children, a son Ron Robert Stitt and a daughter Mindy Stitt Martin. He has three

grandchildren; Brandon Trevor Stitt, Kody Wetzold and Rebecca Jane Martin.
