Johnny Burnett, age 84, passed away peacefully on April 18, 2026. Born on March 13, 1942, Johnny lived a full and meaningful life marked by dedication to his family, his country, and a career that spanned more than four decades.

Johnny proudly served in the United States Air Force, achieving the rank of Sergeant. During his service, he worked on the guns of B-52 aircraft, a role he carried with pride and a sense of humor. He often shared stories of his time in the hangar, including a favorite tale of playfully startling pilots by secretly maneuvering the gun turret-leaving them convinced something mysterious was at work. His storytelling and quick wit were hallmarks of his personality and brought joy to those around him.

Following his military service, Johnny dedicated over 40 years to his career with Ma Bell, later known as US West. His strong work ethic and commitment were evident throughout his long and successful career.
