José Gerardo Ibarra, 65, passed away on January 7th, 2024. He was born to the late Nicolás Ibarra and Hilaria Gómez on January 25th, 1958, in San Luis Potosí, Mexico. José lost both his parents at the age of fourteen, a situation that required him to become responsible for his four siblings at a very young age. He met the love of his life, Ana Reyna Ibarra, in middle school and married her on September 1st, 1978. Ana and José immigrated to the United States in 1990, choosing Corsicana, Texas to settle and raise their four children. In November 1993, José established his own business, Eagle Auto, and ran it for thirty years. José was known affectionately to many close family members and friends as “Pollo.”

Pollo / José was a jack of all trades and the person to go to for any kind of advice or need. He helped his sister-in-law with countless home and yard needs and dispensed aid on numerous other projects both large and small. Pollo also enjoyed taking on construction projects of all sizes. He built several houses, including his son’s home, and he built his granddaughters’ play places. His passion was taking care of others and preparing delicious food for his family and friends. Pollo’s loved ones agree that he was by far the most hard-working man they knew. When he wasn’t working hard at the office or on various projects, Pollo enjoyed relaxing at his lake house on Cedar Creek Lake.

Memories of Pollo/José will be cherished by his wife of 45 years, Ana (Reyna) Ibarra; daughters Ana Edna Ibarra-Avila (John), of Corsicana, Texas; Ana Gabriela “Gabby” Ibarra of Corsicana, Texas; Ana Ximena “Kiki” Ibarra of Austin, Texas; and his son, Cristobal Ibarra (Ashley) of Corsicana, Texas. Also cherishing Pollo’s memory are his three grandchildren, Belén and Frida Avila, and Layla Ibarra. José is also survived by his brothers Santiago and Carlos Ibarra, and his sisters Esther and Francisca Ibarra, as well as many beloved nephews, nieces, cousins, and extended family. José is preceded in death by his parents Nicolás Ibarra and Hilaria Gómez.

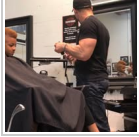
