Josh Douglas Skinner, 51, passed away peacefully at home on Friday morning, December 2, 2022, after a battle with pancreatic cancer. He was surrounded by loved ones and lifted in prayer by special family friend, Steve Burluson. Of those present, none were more important to him than his wife, Lisa and their two sons Ty and Peyton.
