After she and Elton moved their family to Texas, we seldom saw each other, but we always stayed in touch by letters or phone. Every time Sue and Elton would come to Ada to visit their families, Sue would never fail to contact me. We always had so much "catching up" to do that we never felt that we were finished talking. When they would come for family reunions, she insisted that we come eat and spend the day with them. Sue had a way of popping up just when I needed her the most. After I had my mastectomy in 2007, one day I got a call from her saying they were in town and wanted to come see me and take Floyd and me out to eat. Floyd loved being with them almost as much as I did and we counted it an honor to get to see them. Every time we would get together, even if only once or twice a year, it was as if we had never been apart. Then, when Floyd was so ill and dying in Sept., 2014, I called to tell her what was going on. She told me "We'll be right there". I said, "But where are you?" Her answer was "We're in Ada!" They came and stayed with me for several days. Sue would stand beside Floyd's bed and stroke his hand and tell him he didn't have to worry about me and that I would be okay. Her sweet voice soothed him and he would relax and just look up at her and smile. We would all get together in Floyd's room and sing and pray and worship together. In other words, we had church! Then, the night before Floyd's funeral service, they came and she helped put together a memorial book that I had made to honor Floyd. We had quite an assembly line going and Sue kept us all entertained with her wit! I loved that about her! I will never have another friend like Sue! She was one of a kind and I loved her like a sister! I will miss her so much, but I KNOW we'll all be together again ONE DAY!

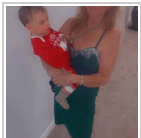
