In more recent years she spent a good deal of her time caring for her parents. She was part of a very close family and we will miss her.

An important part of Suzanne's life was her faith in her heavenly Father, Jehovah. She was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses in the early 70's

and firmly believed in the resurrection hope and the wonderful promise at Isaiah 35: 5 and 6: “The ears of the deaf will be unstopped...and the tongue of the speechless will shout for joy.” Our family looks forward to seeing her again and hearing her voice for the first time and the expression on her face as she hears ours.

Graveside services will be held at 2:00pm on Thursday December 27th at Providence Cemetery in Mildred. Tim McCaa will be officiating and there will be an ASL interpreter for the benefit of her close friends.
