



## Keith Weaver

January 17, 1941 - December 25, 2023

Keith was born in a farmhouse outside of Navarro, Texas to John Leslie and Ida Marie (McCarter) Weaver. He was the youngest of six brothers: Lloyd, Buford, Marion (M.L.), McCarter Clyde (Mac), and Logston. They are again reunited. He graduated Mildred High School in 1959, and proudly joined the United States Air Force. On June 4, 1960, while still a supply Sergeant for the USAF he married Dorothy May Cofield at the Mildred Baptist Church and moved back to Chandler, Arizona, where he was stationed at Williams Air Force Base. After being honorably discharged from the Air Force they moved back to Navarro. His career path took him to work at the Navarro County Electric Co-Op in 1965 where he worked over 30 years, retiring at age 62 in 2003.

Keith was Vice President of the Mildred ISD School Board in the late 70s and early 80s where he was intricate in building a badly needed new school. He was sought out my people of all ages for advice and guidance. While employed with the Co-Op he was able to accrue several college credit hours in math, science, and literature. As an avid hunter he spent his limited free time in the woods with friends he has now rejoined.

He is survived by his loving wife of 63 years, Dorothy, Son Steven Keith, son Michael Lynn and his wife Charlotte, whom he constantly referred to as "Daughter", Grandsons Westly Michael, Morgan Curtis, Payton Lee, Quintin Keith, Grand Daughter Miranda Nicole who will always be his "little princess", Great Grandsons Keegan and Konner Orozco and numerous nieces,

nephews and cousins, most of which refer to him as “Uncle Keith”.
