Kerr Bicknell Cowan, 93, of Corsicana passed away Monday, Jan. 16, 2006 at the family home, where he was born 93 years ago on June 24, 1912.

Visitation will be 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. Wednesday at Griffin-Roughton Funeral Home. Graveside services will be 11:00 a.m. Thursday at Oakwood Cemetery with Father Edward Monk officiating. Born to Horace Kerr Cowan and Virginia Bicknell Cowan, He was a member of St. John's Episcopal Church, A honor student from Corsicana High School in 1929, He went on with a scholarship to New York University. He retired from the U.S. Army in 1968, having served in the Army Air Corps during World War II in the China-Burma-India Theater working on the supply line across the Himalayan Mountains.
