May 6, 1946 - March 18, 2023

Larry James Cammack, 76 of Fairfield, passed away March 18, 2023, at his residence. He was born May 6, 1946, in Longview to James and Bettye Cammack. Larry was a singer songwriter and performed around the country at different venues. He served in the United States Army where he was in the 25th Infantry Division in Vietnam and the 46th Infantry Division. He received the Vietnam Service Medal with 2 Bronze service medals, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, National Defense Service Medal and Combat Infantryman Badge, Bronze Star Medal and Sharpshooter.
