Leonard Mixon, 80, of the Union High Community in Navarro County passed from this life on Wednesday, November 25, 2020 at Providence Hospital in Waco. He was born on Corsicana on May 3, 1940 to Perlle Mixon and Mary Louise Higgins Mixon. He graduated from Corsicana High School in 1958 and married Linda Faye Haley on June 6, 1960 in Dawson. Leonard joined the United States Air Force in 1961 and served until 1965. Following his military service he worked for Texas Instruments until retiring in 1991. During his retirement he served as Director of Navarro County Electric Coop Board, Dawson Lions Club and fire chief for the Union High Volunteer Fire Department. Leonard was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Corsicana.

He is survived by his wife Linda; two sisters Helen Dunlap of Corsicana and Martha Ann Howell of Waxahachie; daughters Machelle of Canyon, Texas and Angela and husband Dale of Amarillo. Three grandchildren; Rhett Schumann of Oklahoma City, Taylor Mixon of Canyon and Bree Mixon of Amarillo.
