When Lillie and Louis retired they returned to Corsicana after living in Tyler, Beaumont, Galveston, Houston and Austin. While in Corsicana they were active members of Westminster Presbyterian Church. She lived her life serving people as a servant to her Lord Jesus Christ. She passed away after almost 12 years of being afflicted by dementia and lived in Groesbeck as well as Plano around her two daughters, Barbara and Betty. The daughters then took over the role of serving their mother as they had seen her doing so many times. She was

preceded in death by her husband, Louis E. Read in 1992; son, John L. Reed; daughter, Barbara Read Turner; and great-grandchild, Derek Day.
