July 16, 1951 - November 28, 2015

Loyd Newton Bratcher of Dawson, TX. passed away on Saturday morning November 28, 2015 at Navarro Regional Hospital at the age of 64. He was born in Fort Worth, TX. to Athal Newton Bratcher and Betty Grimes Bratcher on July 16, 1951. From the age of two till he was eighteen years old he was raised by Stella and Alvin Dechert who he called "mom and uncle". Loyd retired from Ash Grove Cement in Midlothian after 30 plus years where he worked in product shipment and receiving. He married Kim Batchelor on November 25, 1974 in Fort Worth, TX. and they lived in Mansfield, TX. until moving to Dawson, TX. in November 1991 on Thanksgiving Day. Loyd loved being outside hunting coyotes and wild hogs, dove hunting and the evening rides he and Kim would make on their Polaris Ranger on the back roads. Loyd volunteered for 15 years with the Dawson Volunteer Fire Department and was a member of the Tate Springs Baptist Church in Arlington.

He is preceded in death by his parents, daughter Janna Royal and grandchild Daryan Bowling. He is survived by his wife of 41 years Kim Bratcher. 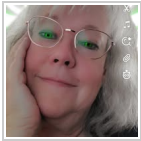
