Mack A. Powers, Sr passed away Thursday, April 15, 2010. He was born May 16, 1935 in El Reno, Ok to O.E. and Ruby (Grogan) Powers, both deceased. Mr. Powers joined the Air Force in 1952 and served as an Electronic Technician, helping to develop the gyroscope for the Aerospace program. He then became a Special Agent in O.S.I. In 1968 he joined the Army in Military Intelligence. He served in both Korean Action and Vietnam War. He retired from the Military in 1972. His final retirement was from the U.S. Postal Service in 1997, where he had served as an Electronic Technician in Tyler. He is survived by his wife of 56 years Joan Close Powers and 2 children Robin Pagel of Fairfield and Mack A. Powers, Jr and wife Melinda of Altus Ok; five grandchildren Stephanie Powers and Michael Powers of Altus Ok, Adam Powers and wife Cerise and Laura Powers all of Lubbock, Katie Pagel of Fairfield. He is also survived by 3 brothers Don Powers and wife Sherry of Rennewick WA, Duane Powers and wife Mary of Inyokern CA, John Powers of Cleveland TN, numerous nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by parents, 3 sisters and 1 brother. Mr. Powers was a Past Master of Masonic Lodge 103, Fairfield and a member of Scottish Rite Body in Waco.
