January 10, 1915 - October 16, 2008

Mamie Thelma (Oliver) Stubbs, 93, died peacefully at Twilight Nursing Home in Corsicana, Texas on Thursday October 16, 2008. Graveside services will be held at Hamilton-Beeman Cemetery at 2pm Friday October 17, 2008. Mamie was born January 10, 1915 in Waco Texas to Robert Lee Oliver and Nora Jane (Hand) Oliver. She was a resident of Corsicana for 82 years. She spent her childhood in the Corsicana State Home making life long friends there. Until her health declined, she greatly enjoyed the annual State Home reunions. She graduated from high school in 1936 and became a full time nanny to Joe Wolen's children. She and Eugene Stubbs were married on December 19, 1936 in Corsicana. She was preceded in death by her husband Eugene Stubbs, in March 1983; son Jodie Eugene; brothers Charlie, Howard, Walter and sister Marion.
