Marion Earl Shurley, 92, formerly of Hobbs, New Mexico passed away at home on November 25, 2010. He was born in Wewoka, Oklahoma in 1918 to Marvin and Ora Lee (Traywick) Shurley. He served in the European Theater in World War II with the 45th Division. He retired from Mobil Oil after 33 years working in New Mexico and West Texas. He was an avid golfer, fisherman, square dancer, hand radio operator and also loved to bowl and travel. He was preceded in death by his mother, father, two sisters and a brother. He is survived by his wife, Marie, having been married for sixty-seven years.
