She fought a brave and courageous battle following surgery for 3 months, always surrounded by loving family, friends and Church family. She celebrated her 70th birthday in the hospital. Martha was born on October 15, 1939 to William Wilson and Bootsie Lester Kirkland. She graduated from Axtell High School in 1957. On August 31, 1957 she married her high school sweetheart Howard Weempe. Three children blessed this union. They were reared in a Christian home full of joy and love for each other. The happy couple celebrated their 50th Wedding anniversary in 2007 with their family and many friends. After moving to Corsicana 24 years ago, Martha became involved with real estate, first as a secretary and then as an Agent after earning her license. She approached her job as Realtor with a cheerful smile treating all with integrity and assisting each to find the ideal home.
