Mary Wanda Anglin Lane of Corsicana passed from this life Friday, August 6, 2021 in Waxahachie, Tx at Baylor Scott & White Hospital. She was born on October 24, 1936 to Warren Weldon Anglin and Minnie May Wilson Anglin in Palestine, Tx. She was the youngest of three children being 18 years younger than her oldest sister. Her father died when she was 3 and her mother remarried when she was 8 to her step-father Charles Woodard Tyer. Mary Wanda was close to her step-daddy and when she was 13 he passed away.

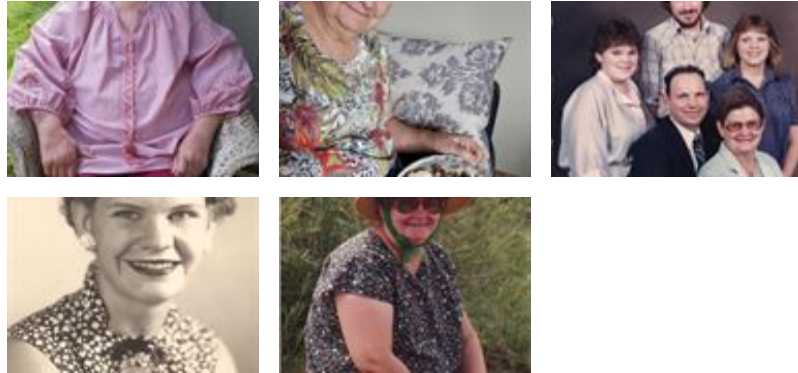
