June 20, 1922 - January 15, 2007

Maxine Sunkel Carroll peacefully passed away after a lengthy battle with Alzheimer's Disease on Monday, January 15, 2007 in Dallas, Texas at the age of 84 years. She was born on June 20, 1922 in Tulare, California to Carolyn Rosenfeld Sunkel and Walter William Sunkel. Maxine grew up in California but came to Texas when she married the one love of her life, Dr. J.D. Carroll, on January 31, 1947, two years to the day after he was freed as a German POW during World War II. J.D. always said his heart was "recaptured" that day, a love that would last 60 years. She was an active member of St. John's Episcopal Church, where she served as Altar Guild Directress and on the vestry. Additionally she was involved in many community volunteer activities. Maxine especially loved Aggie football games and was a loyal supporter of Texas A&M University, alma mater of her husband and daughters. Survivors include her husband Dr. J.D. Carroll, her daughters, "the three C's" Carla Carroll Thomas, Candace Carroll Grady, and Courtney Corinne Carroll, all of Dallas. Sons-in-law: Dr. Robert Thomas and Douglas S. Grady. Grandson Zachary W. Thomas. Sisters: Margery S. Brown of Los Gatos, CA., and Carol S. Auslen of Lake Tahoe, NV. Her brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law: Dr. Ray Dean and Lula Carroll, Rudy and Billie Carroll, all of Corsicana, Frances Holdeman of Mansfield, Lorraine Carroll of Blooming Grove and many nieces and nephews from Texas, California, and Nevada. Her family is forever grateful for the loving care given her by her faithful companions: Coretta Davis, Jannie Scott, Kim Davis, Ella Hardman, and the late Karen Gipson, as

well as the staff at Signature Pointe on the Lake, Dallas, Texas. In addition the family wishes to thank Ellen Levene of Corsicana. A memorial service will be held Friday, January, 19, 2007 at 11:00 a.m. at St. John's Episcopal Church with Father Edward Monk officiating.
