Michael “Mike” Glenn Hopson passed away August 8th at 5:53 with his family by his side. Mike was born in Corsicana, TX on November 20, 1963. He is a graduate of Dawson High School and remained in the Corsicana area with his wife and sons.

“Hoppy” as he was often called, began working in law enforcement in Ellis County in 1984.

Over his 35+ year career in law enforcement, he served as a jailor, Patrol Officer, Criminal

Investigator, Detective Sergeant, Narcotics, Criminal Investigations Lieutenant, and Criminal

Investigations Captain. He embraced all of these roles with unwavering dedication, going above

Mike was a devoted husband of almost 40 years to his wife Dianne. He was a cherished member of his extended family and always brought the laughs with his quick wit and dry humor. If you ever wanted the truth, Mike was the guy to ask. Mike was reliable, stubborn, respectable, and hard-working. His entire family is proud of his accomplishments, proud of his dedication, and proud of the man he was.
