Nancy Louise Bromonsky, formerly of Richland, passed away on Monday, September 12, 2011 at Parkview Regional Hospital in Mexia at the age of 81. She was born on July 8, 1930 in Corsicana to Louis Earl Stallings and Jessie Alma Glasgow Stallings. Known as Louise by most people, she worked for the glove factory in Corsicana as a seamstress / turner for a number of years. She attended church services at the Heavenly Days Country Holiness Church in Richland.
