Noelle Daniel Glass was born on October 5th 1955 in Fairfield, Texas and passed away unexpectedly at her home in Streetman, Texas on April 30, 2016.

Noelle was the only daughter of Sam and Doris Daniel and many family members referred to her as "baby sister". She had three older brothers, Ponte Daniel, Sammy Wayne Daniel, and Stephen Childs Daniel

Noelle spent almost her entire life in Fairfield. During this time she began working with the family restaurant business at the age of 15. After graduating from Fairfield High School in 1974, she attended Navarro College and Sam Houston State University. On March 23, 1990 she married Mike Glass in Las Vegas, Nevada; they had just celebrated 26 years of marriage.

Noelle's love of life, caring

heart and generosity will be greatly missed by her family, friends and her "restaurant" family.

She is preceded in death by her parents and her brothers Stephen Daniel and Sammy Wayne Daniel.

Noelle is survived by her husband, Mike Glass, her children Bryan Glass and wife Janis and Melisa Noland and husband BJ. 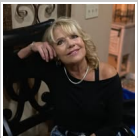
