Pamela Tramel O'Hanlon, 58, was laid to rest yesterday next to her mother who preceded her in death by only nine months. Following her request, there was no public service. She died Saturday, March 20th at her home in Corsicana. She was born July 4, 1951 to the late Millie Tramel and late C.N. Tramel Sr. Perhaps because of her birthday, she had a special respect for the American flag and organized a ceremony to retire Navarro County flags that had become torn and tattered. She was passionate about educating people on the proper way to dispose of flags. Known as a consummate storyteller, she could have people rolling in laughter. Her dry wit and wicked sense of humor brought happiness to all those who knew her. She was a graduate of Corsicana High School and attended North Texas State University. She is survived by her daughter Erin Carlyle; her son in law Jeff Carlyle; her grandchildren Callie Carlyle and Jackson Carlyle of Houston; her sister and brother in law Linda and Mark Quick of Houston; brother Clif Tramel of Weatherford; uncle Larry Hickson of Austin; numerous cousins and family friends and her companion, Wesley Allen.
