But her favorite thing besides helping kids and baking after school cookies for her grandchildren was going to garage sales and church sales with her best friends to sell on eBay. This enabled her to make many donations to support the First Methodist Youth Group with their mission trips and other activities. She even promised to go back to the Plano Stroke Institute one day to teach the nurses that were so kind to her after her stroke to crochet too.

Corsicana, Mandy Newgard of Flagstaff, AZ, and Chris Goodman of McGregor, TX, their spouses Ricky Grantham, Greg Newgard, and Olivia Goodman, her grandchildren Andy Grantham, Brady Grantham, Cameron Newgard, Austin Newgard, Addy Goodman, and Mia Goodman.

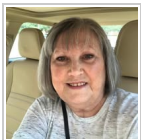

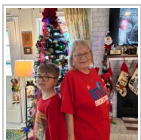
