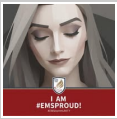

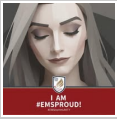

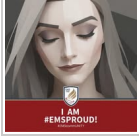
“ I sadly never really knew her, but I went to school with her daughter Frances my entire school life

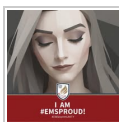
