Patsy Ruth Lee Stroud, passed away July 9, 2013, at Fairfield Nursing and Rehab Center, in Fairfield, TX. She was born March 3, 1929, to William Link and Nancy Geneva Lee, in Corsicana. Patsy married Wiley D. Stroud, August 23, 1946.

Patsy lived most of her adult life in Fairfield and surrounding communities. She was a homemaker and stay at home mom until her children were both in school. In 1961, she became deputy in the Freestone County Tax Office. She continued working in this position until 1980, when she appointed Tax Collector to finish out the term of office after the passing of Jerry Jones. Patsy continued to hold this position until her retirement in 1992, having served three terms. For several years, she was a member of the Fairfield History Club. Patsy was a member of First Baptist Church in Fairfield, until the family moved from Stewards Mill to Streetman, where she became a member of First Baptist Church, in Streetman. During this time, she served as the pianist for all the worship services and often played for both of her children to sing special music during the Sunday morning worship services. In 1972, Patsy and Wiley moved to Fairfield, where they continued to attend church at First Baptist in Fairfield.

Patsy was preceded in death by both her parents, her husband and an infant daughter, Sherry Sue Stroud.

She is survived by one son Lyndon Link Stroud, wife, Grace of Fort Worth. A daughter, Patti Ballard, husband, Elmer of Fairfield. Three grandsons, Phillip
