Patty Lou Singleton Toland was born November 17, 1936 and went to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on January 26, 2023, after a short illness. She was a graduate of Mildred High School, El Centro College, and Southern Methodist University School of Nursing class of 1959.

She married the love of her life Bobby Toland on August 18, 1957. She began her nursing career at Methodist Hospital in Dallas. After 15 years with Methodist Hospital, Bobby and Patty moved back to Corsicana where she began her 45 years of service with Navarro Regional Hospital as a nurse. She was the recipient of numerous awards including Employee of the Year, the Dr. Frist Humanitarian Award, and the prestigious Daisy Award of Excellence. After retirement, she continued her commitment to nursing and others by volunteering at Navarro Regional Hospital until the age of 83. Mrs. Toland was a dedicated member of Providence Missionary Baptist Church for over 50 years where she was involved in many church activities. She took great joy from being with her family, helping others in need, and above all, serving her Lord and Savior.

She was preceded in death by her parents B.E. and Verla Singleton; her husband Bobby Ray Toland; granddaughter Amanda Kae Tidwell; her sisters Helen Price and Laverne Galaway; and her brother Johnny Singleton. She is survived by her brother Robert Singleton, wife Martha; brother-in-law Nelson Galaway; sister-in-law Elizabeth Singleton; and numerous nieces, nephews, and friends.
