



Rae Elaine Goldstucker Silverberg

January 5, 1931 - April 29, 2019

Elaine was born in Tyler, Texas, the youngest of three children of Nathan and Celia Goldstucker. Growing up in Tyler, Elaine graduated from John Tyler High School and attended Tyler Junior College where she was one of the members on the very first Apache Belles dance squad.

She met Herb Silverberg at The University of Texas but did not begin dating until Elaine moved back to Ft. Worth and graduated from TCU with a degree in Education. Although Elaine never taught inside a classroom, she worked with her kids at home, teaching them useful things like cooking and folding sheets.

Elaine married Herb on March 1, 1959. Soon after, they welcomed son Kal and two years later, said hello to son David. They had numerous adventures ever since. Trips to Chicago in the summer when it was 40 degrees, road trips to Miami Beach and Disney World, a train trip to San Francisco, and an 8-hour flight to Hawaii highlighted family vacations.

Elaine was a Past President of the Navarro Regional Hospital Auxiliary and volunteered over 1500 hours. She was also the first President of the Corsicana Lioness Club, a women's offshoot of Lions International.

Elaine is survived by her son Kal, his wife Karen, and their son Steven, his fiancée Jessica, and daughter Sarah. She is also survived by her youngest son David, his wife Felice, and their children Ryan and Jessica.

Her funeral was held Tuesday, April 30th, at Griffin-Roughton Funeral Home, with internment next to her husband of 57 years, Herb, in the Corsicana
