Raymond Ed Wilson, 75, of Lancaster, Texas, passed away on Thursday, October 17, 2024, at the Veterans Hospital in Dallas. Born on January 9, 1949, in Kerens, Texas, Raymond was the son of the late Theodore and Mallie Wilson.
