On the afternoon of Friday, June 6th, 2025, Rickey passed away peacefully where he was surrounded by loved ones. He was seventy-one years old. Rickey was born in the town of Corsicana, Texas on October 4th, 1953. He was the first child of the late Margaret and Dewey Hickson.

Rickey was a graduate of Corsicana High School in 1972 and later attended Texas A&M University. He graduated with a Bachelor's in Biology and he went on to further his academics with a medical technology certificate from Navarro College. He then worked for Medical Arts Clinic for twenty-five years and later retired.

As a child, Rickey had many friends where they enjoyed gathering for a game at Beebe field, which he let his little sister attend. He loved playing football in the street where traffic wasn't an issue in those days. As an adult, Rickey enjoyed golf with his buddies where he never liked to keep score and just liked to play.
