Robert “Bob” Lindsay passed away of natural causes while fishing near his home on Richland Chambers Reservoir on the morning of June 12, 2015. He was 69 years old.

Bob was born in St Cloud, Minnesota. He grew up in Cambridge, MN and graduated from Cambridge High School in 1965. During the Vietnam War, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served in Korea. When he returned home, he married Linda Torell and they had a daughter, Kendell. He graduated from St. Cloud Technical School in 1972 and shortly after moved his family to Texas. Eventually they settled in Houston and Bob spent 38 years in Houston before retiring in 2015 to Streetman, Texas. He spent the last 14 years of his career as a Senior Electrical Technician at OFI Testing Equipment where he traveled to several different countries including China, Russia, Singapore, Venezuela, and Columbia. He enjoyed fishing, working on electronics, and fixing cars.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Alfred and Olga Lindsay, and brother Roger Lindsay. He is survived by his daughter, Kendell Lindsay and son-in-law, Karl Petersen, wife, Linda Lindsay, brothers, George (Barb) Lindsay and Harold (Barb) Lindsay, sisters, Sandra Yerigan and Annie (Gerald) Lindsay, sister-in-law, Lucy Bunnell, and several nieces, nephews, life-long friends, and colleagues.
