Robert L. (Bob) Vaughn of Dallas, Texas passed away December 31, 2020 at the age of 91. He was born July 31, 1929 in Vernon, Texas to William A. Vaughn and Estelle Irene Glover Vaughn. After graduating from Vernon High School he attended the University of North Texas in Denton and studied music. In July 1955 he married Bonnie Richardson of Dallas. In 1961 Vaughn began building custom front doors, entrances and millwork for both residential and commercial construction under the name Wood Products Co. He retired in 1999.
