Rodney Lane Burt was born in Dallas, TX on April 25, 1932 and passed away peacefully in Corsicana, TX on November 17, 2024. He was a beloved son of Smoot Brunet Burt and Harriet Eula Nowlin Burt.

He graduated from Sunset High School in Dallas, TX in 1950.

Rodney began his military service during the Korean War. He served in the U. S. Army and the Army Reserve from June 1955 to November 1959. He completed Basic Training at Fort Bliss in El Paso, TX and was stationed in San Francisco, CA as a Missile Launch Crewman. He was awarded the National Defense Service Medal. He was very proud of his service to the United States of America.

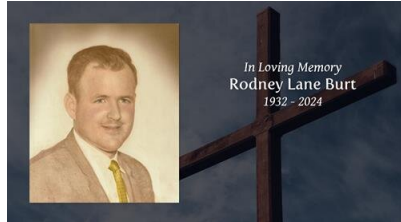
