Visitation will be held from noon to 2 p.m. Saturday at Griffin-Roughton Funeral Home. Following cremation, a memorial service dedicated to the celebration of his life on this earth will be at 2 p.m. Saturday at Griffin-Roughton Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Chris Moody officiating. Jea Milam was born Nov. 9, 1959, in Corpus Christi. He was a 1978 graduate from Corsicana High School. Jea, partnered with his dad, Jerry, owned Tri County Properties. He loved music, mastering guitar and harmonica and played with several of the local bands in the area. He was honored to play on stage with Toby Keith when he was in the Dallas area.
