Through his love, his faith, and his words, Sean touched lives—and he led many souls to the Lord.

Sean was an old soul with a rock-and-roll heart. Music was his rhythm and his refuge. He loved those long, easy moments of conversation and laughter—where stories, songs, and a little quiet reflection made the world slow down. Those who knew him best will smile at that memory, knowing exactly the kind of peace he loved to share.

Sean loved God deeply. His faith was personal, unshakable, and filled with grace. He often reminded those around him to hold on to their faith, to love without judgment, and to never be afraid to lean on the Lord. His greatest wish was for his family and friends to find peace in that same love and to accept Jesus as their Savior.

He believed that love was the truest legacy a person could leave behind—and his own life proved it. His family was his pride, his joy, and his purpose.
