Sharon was extremely intelligent, with a quick wit accented by a touch of sarcasm. A great sense of humor. She was tough. A cancer survivor. She had perseverance & fortitude, two of the McCraw family traits.

A women of faith. Honest, almost to a fault at times. Dependable. All the things that made her a special sweet loving person we all adored. My big sissy, greatly missed & always loved.
