Sybil Minshew Sehon, of Corsicana, passed away December 25, 2012 at the age of 100. She was born in Quanah, TX on July 22, 1912 to Cliff and Etta Minshew. She graduated from Clara High School in Clara, TX in 1930, and married her high school sweetheart, J.O. Sehon, in November, 1930. They were married for 67 years, and were blessed with two children, John and Shirley.

Sybil spent the majority of her adult life living in West Texas, spending many of those years living in various oil field camps in Pampa, Denver City, Midland, Lefors and Odessa. Her husband, J.O. was a Gauger and then a Supervisor for Humble Oil (Exxon Mobil) for his entire career, which led to their active involvement in the Exxon Annuitants club for many years.

Sybil was proud to be a housewife, who never worked outside the home, except for the one season when she picked cotton so that she could buy a leather coat for her husband.

She was an avid fan of the Texas Rangers and the Dallas Mavericks and enjoyed spending many hours playing games with her family and friends, having perfected her "9 hole golf" game. Sybil also enjoyed her many pets, even the turtles that lived in her

backyard and returned year after year.

She was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, and great grandmother who was actively interested in all her grandchildren and great grandchildren's activities and accomplishments.

She moved to Corsicana from Odessa in March of 2002 to be near her daughter and son-in-law.

One of her proudest moments was reaching her 100th birthday, and she enjoyed her birthday celebration in July with all of her family and many friends in attendance.

She was preceded in death by her husband, J.O Sehon.
