Her passion and love were her kids and grandkids. She believed that the sound of a child’s laugh was the sound of heaven on earth. Terrie had a contagious laugh, sparkling smile, was a spit fire, the life of the party, spoke her mind, and always had a hug to give. Above all, she loved her family

beyond measure.
