Tom Bunch passed away February 4, 2008 at Heritage Oaks Retirement Village surrounded by his family and wonderful caretakers. Tom was born March 8, 1920 in Fort Worth Texas to parents Adolphus and Bernice Bunch.

Tom came to Corsicana in 1941 as a flying instructor for Air Activities of Texas. In 1942 Tom met and married Yevonne Barnaby. Soon after their marriage, Tom joined the United States Navy. He taught flying and later transported supplies and personnel into the war zone in the South Pacific.

After the war ended, Tom and Yevonne lived in Chicago and Kansas City before moving to Dallas Texas. Tom began his career as an investment broker. In 1958 Tom and Yevonne moved back to Corsicana to raise their children. Tom continued his career in Dallas, but also began investing in Corsicana. Tom built the first apartment complex in Corsicana, and later built and developed Park Place Townhouses. Tom was an avid golfer, and loved to travel, and spend time with his family. Tom is survived by his wife Yevonne, son Bob and wife Lilia of Houston, daughter Kendra of Corsicana, grandson Bill of San Diego and Thomas of Houston and his beloved pug Sofie
