Thomas Neil Wood, 71, of Corsicana passed away December 7, 2006 in Dallas, Texas at the North Texas Veterans Administration Medical Center. He was born in Frost, Texas on April 9, 1935 and attended Corsicana Schools, graduating from Baylor University with a BA and MA degrees in History/Government. After graduating from Baylor he served in the United State Army and was stationed in Germeany.
