Travis Miles Coe, loving husband, father, grandfather with a great sense of humor, passed away on Tuesday, February 1, 2011 in Corsicana at the age of 73. He was born on April 28, 1937 in Corsicana to Basil Coe and Dell Fullwood Coe. Travis served in the United States Navy in the late 1950's and was the owner of Miles Furniture in Corsicana from 1979 - 2004. Travis is survived by his wife Jeannie Coe of Corsicana.
