



## W.A. (Dub) Fielden

W.A (Dub) Fielden, 84, of Corsicana, passed away Tuesday, January 29th, 2019 at his home.

Dub was born July 10, 1934 in Sulphur Springs, TX to Willie and Opal (Lindsey) Fielden. Upon graduation from Sulphur Springs High School, he entered the US Army.
