September 18, 1914 - January 23, 2007

Wayne Turner Burkhalter, 92, passed away Tuesday, Jan. 23, 2007, in Dallas. Visitation will be held from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Friday at Chatfield United Methodist Church. Service will be 2 p.m. Friday at Chatfield United Methodist Church. Interment will follow at New Chatfield Cemetery. Grandsons will serve as pallbearers. Mr. Burkhalter was born Sept. 18, 1914, in Eustace to William Frederick Burkhalter and Effie Mae Hall Burkhalter. He was a member of Chatfield Methodist Church. He was a cattle rancher, was a member of Woodmen of the World, ran a grocery store in Chatfield, was president of the Chatfield Water Board, built the Chatfield Community Center, and lobbied to have FM 1603 put in. He was known for playing the piano. He was preceded in death by his son, Wayne Burkhalter Jr.; one sister and three brothers. Survivors include his wife, Bobbie Burkhalter of Chatfield; children, Sherry Bancroft of Roane, Judy Jones of Ennis, Janet Wilson of Chatfield and Peggy Drane of Corsicana; numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and sister, Dorothy Keeling of Dallas.
